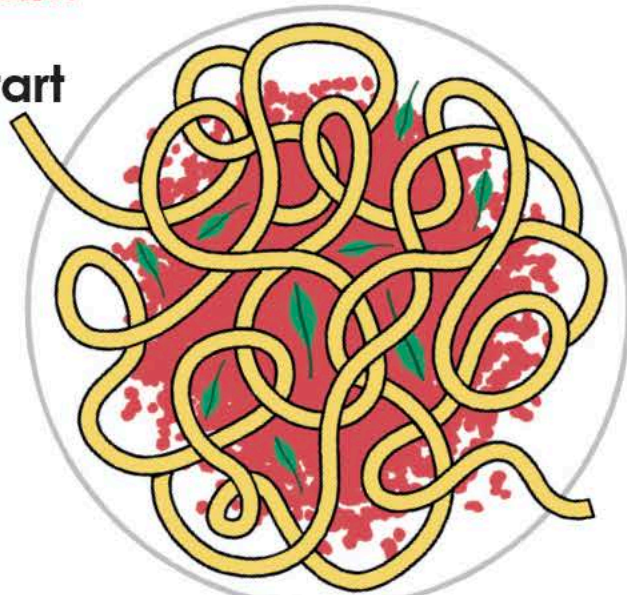

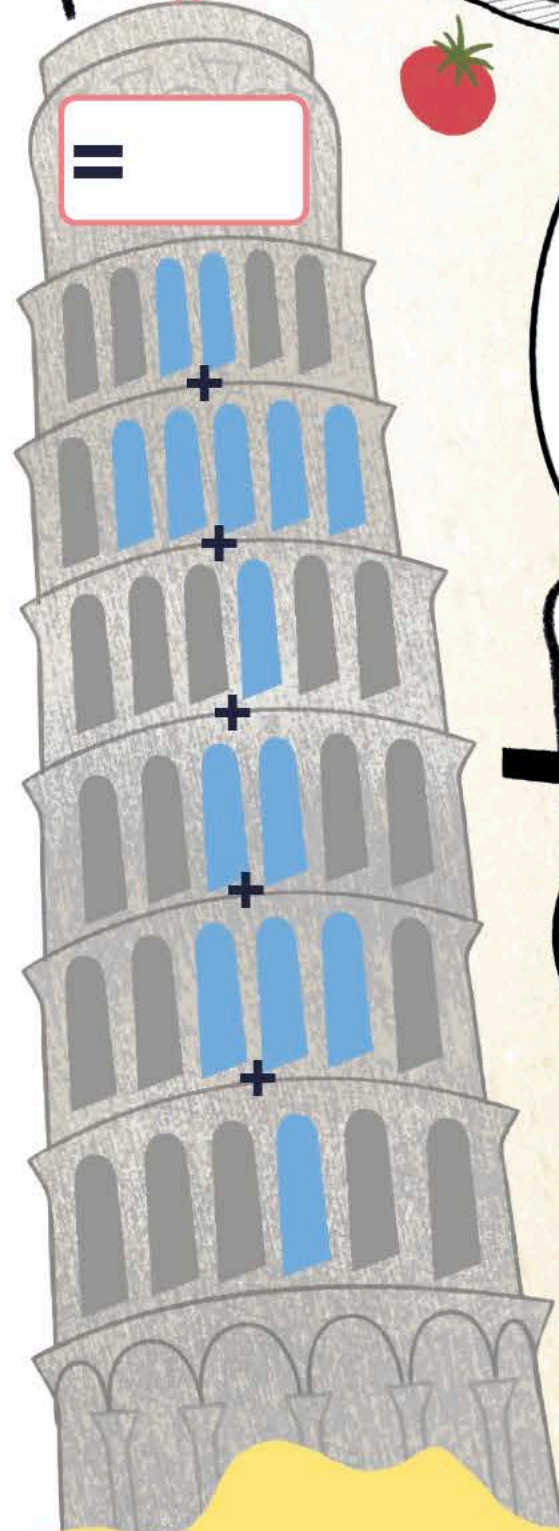
Find your way through the spaghetti maze!

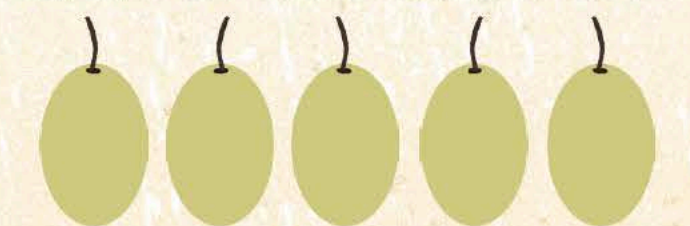
